Thank you so much for your patience as families and staff facilitate dismissal time in the afternoon. The 9/10 children and their siblings should be picked up in the rear of the building. With respect to the pick up area in the front of our school, we are implementing some new steps. Students will continue to stand with their learning groups; however, the 7/8s will stand on the west side of the Downtown School front door and the 5/6s will now stand on the east side of the Downtown School front door. There will be three pick up stations, each supervised by a teacher, marked with colored signs - blue, red, and green. Families will be greeted as they enter the circle drive by a teacher who will then alert the learning groups that you are here. Your child will be directed to the next available color station where you will stop to pick them up. Following the procedures below will help ensure safety and efficiency.

- Be prepared to share your child's name and teacher's name with the teacher greeting families.
- Remain in your car at all times. Please do not leave your car in order to put your child into the vehicle on the driver's side or to assist their child in buckling.
- Ensure your child is able to buckle themselves independently and seated on the right hand side of the car.
- For families who are walking up to the building to meet their child, please wait in the applicable 5/6 area or the 7/8 area as designated above.

Just a reminder **when dropping students off in the front**, please drive your car as far into the circle drive as possible so we can accommodate as many vehicles as possible.
