#### DTS Families,

My name is Barbara Hogan, and this upcoming year will be my 10th as a school counselor for DMPS. I am so excited to be at The Downtown School and can't wait for the year to get underway. I wanted to take a few moments to tell you about my background, role, and school counseling services.

I am a Des Moines native and proud graduate of Roosevelt High School. I went to the University of Kansas to receive my bachelor's degree in social work, followed by a master's degree in counseling from Drake University. After a practicum at Carlisle Middle School and an internship at Perkins Elementary, I served as the school counselor at Walnut Street School and Wright Elementary. Throughout my 9 years as a counselor, I have been in various additional roles at the building and district level including on the Counseling Leadership Team and the District Grief Response Team. Two of my proudest career accomplishments include implementing a successful 5-year therapy dog program and being awarded DMPS Elementary School Counselor of the Year in 2021.

I am passionate about mental health, social-emotional learning, and a whole child approach. The role of a school counselor is to improve student success (academic, career, and social/emotional development) for ALL students. Direct services provided include delivery of the district core counseling curriculum (classroom/large group counseling); individual and small group counseling that is short-term and solution-focused; support and delivery of social-emotional/behavioral interventions; and crisis response services. Indirect services include consultation; collaboration with parents/caregivers, staff, and stakeholders; and referrals for long-term/outside counseling services or assistance. Parents/caregivers and staff may refer a student for school counseling services, or students may refer themselves. To build rapport with students and ensure an accessible program, I intend to meet with every student individually for a brief check-in at least once during the school year.

I am also the 504 Coordinator for DTS. 504 plans are part of a civil rights law that ensures students with disabilities have equal access to the learning in their general education classroom through necessary accommodations. A student is eligible for a 504 plan after an evaluation which finds that the student has a mental or physical impairment that substantially limits a major life activity. If you have concerns about your student's ability to access the learning in their classroom, please first reach out to their classroom teacher. If you would like to talk more about the 504 evaluation process, please reach out to me. I am looking forward to getting to know your student(s) and working with your family! If there is anything I can do to help support your student, please don't hesitate to reach out as we begin the year.


